Here the discussion may evolve around 3 types of the project work (Kolmos 1996), building on Workshop 1, including the issues and challenges of progression:

- 1) **Assignment project:** characterized by a considerable planning and control by the teachers/supervisors. in an assignment-based project the 'problem and the subject' as well as the methods are chosen beforehand.
- 2) **Subject project:** characterized by the subjects chosen beforehand. The students have a free choice either of a problem within the subject or the problem will be given and the students have a 'free choice among a number of described methods'.
- 3) **Problem project:** is based on problems as the starting point means that the problem will determine the choice of disciplines and methods which correspond to the original idea of a problem-oriented learning process where the students have to start with a problem and analyse it, find fundamental solutions to the problem, choose the right solution and outline strategies for implementation.
