2001

- Started PhD on De-internationalization of small hightechnology ventures from international entrepreneurship perspective
- > Challenges
 - > De-internationalization as a black-box
 - > IE = IB + Ent
 - > IB mature field
 - > Ent emerging field

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Back to the past



> 2002

- How the intersection looks like
 - Coviello, N. and Jones, M. (2002) working paper on methodological issues in IE (later published in JBV 2004)
 - > Key finding
 - > IE research is dominated by IB
 - Out of 36 papers only 1 paper conceptualized the intersection: IB & Ent
 - The other 35 conceptualized IE only from IB perspective
 - Same conclusion reached recently by Keupp & Gassmann (2009)

Back to the past



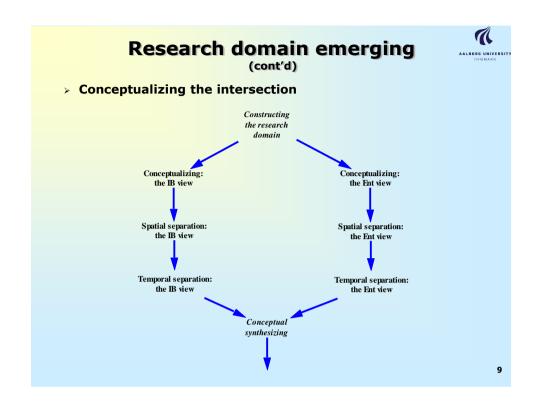
- > 2003

 - > Another attempt

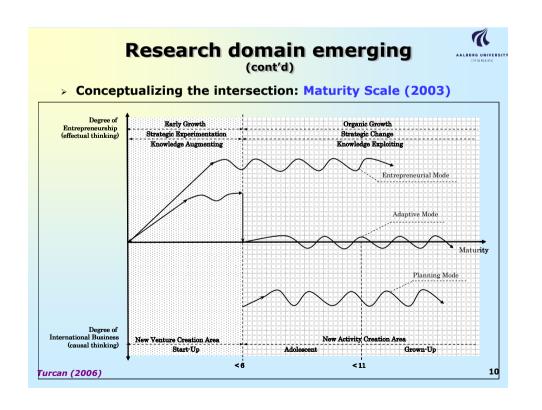
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Research domain emerging



- > 2000 (McDougall & Oviatt)
 - IE is a combination of innovative, proactive, and riskseeking behaviour that crosses national borders and is intended to create value in organizations.
- 2003 (Turcan)
 - IE is a process of discovering and exploiting international venture ideas that are intended to create new values in organizations and in the marketplace.
- 2005 (Oviatt & McDougall)
 - IE is the discovery, enactment, evaluation, and exploitation of opportunities – across national borders – to create future goods and services.
- > 2005 (Turcan)
 - IE is the emergence of international venture ideas which are intended to create new values in organizations and in the marketplace





What about the intersection?



- Is it IB + Ent?
 - How much we actually borrow from IB to inform IE?
- > Is it Strategic Management & Ent?
 - Maybe SM could explain more behaviours of INVs
- Are there any other/more disciplines to borrow from?
 - E.g., 2014 ETP special issue on IE edited by McDougall-Covin, Jones and Serapio
- > Are we in the wrong place at the right time?
 - > Shall we revisit the intersection?

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Advancing IE field



- Conceptualize IE research in the IE emergent domain
- Experiment/Innovate with the intersection
- > Debate the intersection
- > Conduct cross-disciplinary research
- > Borrow from these disciplines
- Move from description (story telling) to middle-range theorising
- > Move beyond substantive areas and advance formal theories
